Principal's Message

Welcome back to school! It is hard to believe that January is already upon us. We hope that everyone had a good Winter break and was able to fit in some time for relaxing.

January is shaping up once again to be a busy month.

We would like to encourage all grade 4 and 7 parents at SouthPointe School to provide feedback to us by completing the Accountability Pillar Survey. The data collected through the survey provides feedback on areas where we are doing well and areas where we need to improve. This feedback helps us to measure how we are doing in reaching our school and district goals. The survey is short but the information provided is greatly appreciated. Please take the time to provide your input. All parents will receive survey packages mailed from Alberta Education. We will also have laptops set up during parent teacher interviews for parents to complete the survey online while they are waiting to see their child's teacher.

The school calendar for the 2019-20 school year has been approved. A copy has been posted on the website for your information. We are beginning to start the process for enrolment and registration for next year. If you have a child that will be entering ECS in the fall of 2019, registration will open February 1, 2019 and we encourage parents to register their children as early as possible. This allows us to have a better idea of how many classes will be needed for next year. Please remember that your child must be 5 years old by December 31, 2019 to enter ECS in the fall. All ECS registrations for the 2019-20 school year will be completed online. The online registration form can be found on our school website www.eips.ca/kindergarten.

Effective for the 2019-20 school year, Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) is once again conducting an online student registration process to confirm the school their children will attend. Access to this form will be through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. All student registration need to be confirmed from February 1-28, 2019.

Our next Parent/Teacher/Student interviews will take place on February 5-6, 2019 from 4:30-7:30 p.m. We will once again be using the online booking system for scheduling interviews. Bookings will be open Friday, January 25 at noon. Go to www.schoolinterviews.ca and use event code: ymc4e. We will be hosting a book fair during interview nights.

Returning Student Registration for 2019-20

Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) will once again conduct an online returning student registration process to confirm student registrations for the 2019-20 school year. Families of all returning students will need to complete this process to confirm the school their children will attend for the 2019-20 school year, and to request to attend a non-designated school, if applicable. Returning student registration will take place at the same time as all registrations for the 2019-20 school year: **Feb. 1-28, 2019**.

Access to the Returning Student Registration Form is provided through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. If you don't have a PowerSchool Parent Portal account, you will need to set one up before Feb. 1, 2019. To create a PowerSchool Parent Portal account:

- 1. Go to https://powerschool.eips.ca/public/.
- 2. Click the button labelled, "Create Account."
- Enter the parent or guardian information. Each account must have a unique email address and username—only one parent account is required regardless of the number of children you have attending EIPS schools.
- 4. Create a username and password of your choice—you'll need both the username and password to log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal.
- 5. You must have an Access ID and Access Password for each student that is added to your account. Contact your child's school to obtain this information.
- 6. Press "Enter."

Accountability Pillar Survey

As an annual check-up on the education system, the Accountability Pillar provides an opportunity for Alberta Education and school authorities to ensure that we are equipping students for success.





The Accountability Pillar uses a set of 16 indicators. Data on these indicators consists of surveys of students, parents and teachers on various aspects of education quality, student outcomes such as dropout and high school completion rates, and provincial assessments of student learning.

From January to the end of February, Alberta Education will be conducting the annual Accountability Pillar Survey.

- In January, parents of students in grades 4, and 7 will receive a survey from Alberta Education.
- In February, students in grades 4 and 7 and all teachers will be completing their surveys online at school.

All surveys are anonymous and ask questions about experiences with your school. In addition to English and French, the parent survey is available in Chinese, Punjabi, Arabic, Blackfoot, Dene, Cree, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Urdu.

Your participation in the survey helps provide important information on the quality of education your child is receiving, so we encourage you to return your survey promptly.

Survey results will be available to school authorities in May, and will be reported publicly as part of their 3-Year Education Plans and Annual Education Results Reports.

posted on www.eips.ca and school websites, Twitter, Facebook, local radio stations, and on Versatrans My Stop.

Decisions regarding bus cancellations are guided by EIPS administrative procedures that states: "school bus service may be suspended when...Environment Canada reports a temperature of -40 C." Other reasons for suspending or delaying school bus services include adverse weather and poor road condition.

When school bus services are suspended, schools will remain open to students. EIPS believes parents have the right and responsibility to make choices for their children based on their beliefs and perceptions of safety during times of inclement weather.
