 - o EIPS policy dictates closed boundaries for schools at 92%+ capacity due to space issues
 - o SPS capacity is 501 students; projection for 2019-2020 school year is 468 students
 - Only new students who are non-designated will be turned away; current students and their siblings will not be turned away even if they are outside of the designated area
 - SPS has requested 4 modulars for next year; if none are allotted, additional junior high classes will be held in underutilized spaces
 - Returning student registration on PowerSchool is February 1 28, 2019

 - Organized by Jocelyn Soontiens
 - o Freson Bros will provide information about the vegetable or fruit provided
 - o Jocelyn Soontiens is organizing a group of parents to come in and prepare donated food
