- Parent Survey Results

  - Looking into providing a review similar to the midpoint review for January through June to keep parents informed

- School Budget will be allotted on May 31 and must be returned by June 7
  - o Budget will provide a better idea of staffing for next school year

  - Looks like 3 million shortfall reserves are no longer able to "top up" as we have done in the past because we have reached the 2% threshold
  - o Makes difficult to create budget based on assumptions, projections and unknowns

    - 7-12 able to access for educational purpose only in class, and, during transitions and lunch
