



Dear Parents/Guardian:

Thank you for your patience and understanding in these unprecedented times. As you are aware, at the direction of Alberta Health Services, school is currently closed to students and community. Our number one priority is the health and safety of all of our students and staff. Over the coming days EIPS will continue to work with Alberta Education and the Provincial Health Authority and make decisions accordingly in regards to student learning.

In an effort to have students prepared for learning from home, we are scheduling 10-minute time slots on **Thursday, March 19 and Friday, March 20** between the hours of 8:30 am - 2:50 pm, during which time students and/or parents will have access to the school to collect their belongings and return library books, home reading books and/or textbooks. To facilitate this we will be using an online booking platform (same as for booking parent teacher interviews).

Arriving for Your Pick up Time

- For everyone's health and safety, please self-assess your health before coming. If you aren't feeling well, or fit into one of the criteria for self-isolation, please make alternate arrangements, e.g., another parent will gather your child's belongings, and advise the school.
- As we are adhering to AHS guidelines, we have a small window of time for each group. Please arrive as close to the start of your assigned time slot as possible and efficiently gather your/your child's belongings.
- Everyone must enter through the bus loop doors (nearest the gym) only. There will be no access to the front office or teachers/classrooms.
- Children do not need to accompany parents to pick up their belongings.
- Students in grades 4–9 may pick up their belongings on their own. If desired, one parent may accompany students.
- All student's belongings are being gathered by staff (including items in lockers), labelled and laid out, by class, in the gym.
- Gym bathroom lockers are being emptied and placed on a table in the gym. Junior high students should look through the items there as well.
- Grade 4-6 indoor shoes that were left on boot racks have been placed on tables in the gym, please don't forget to gather your shoes.
